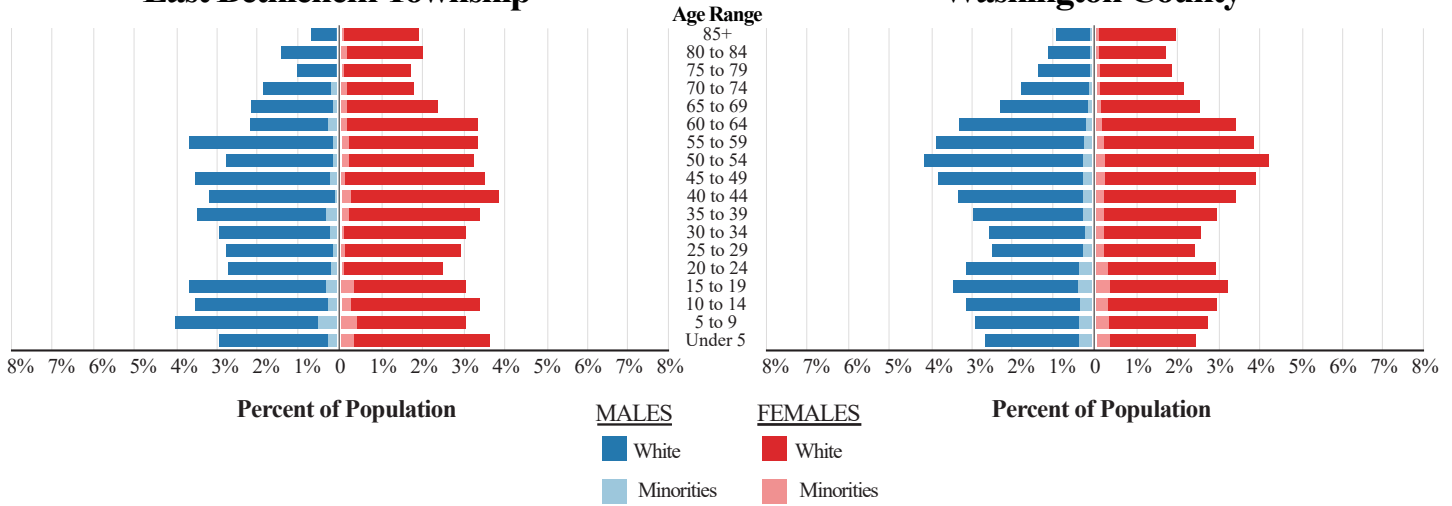

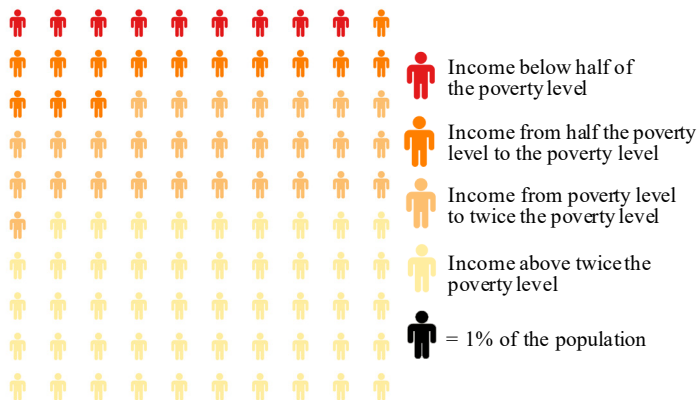
50. Population Distribution By Age

East Bethlehem Township

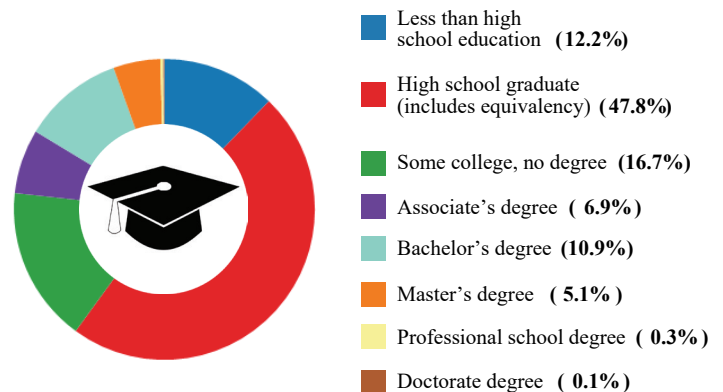

51. Ratio of Income to Poverty Level

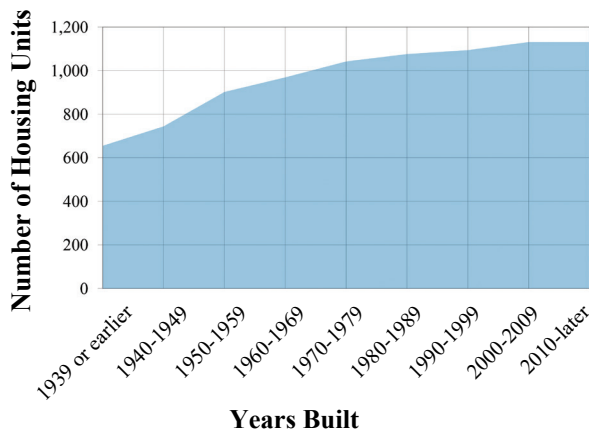


52. Educational Attainment

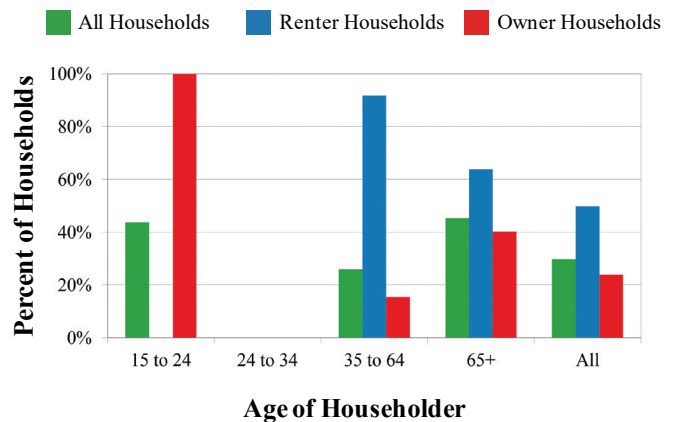
