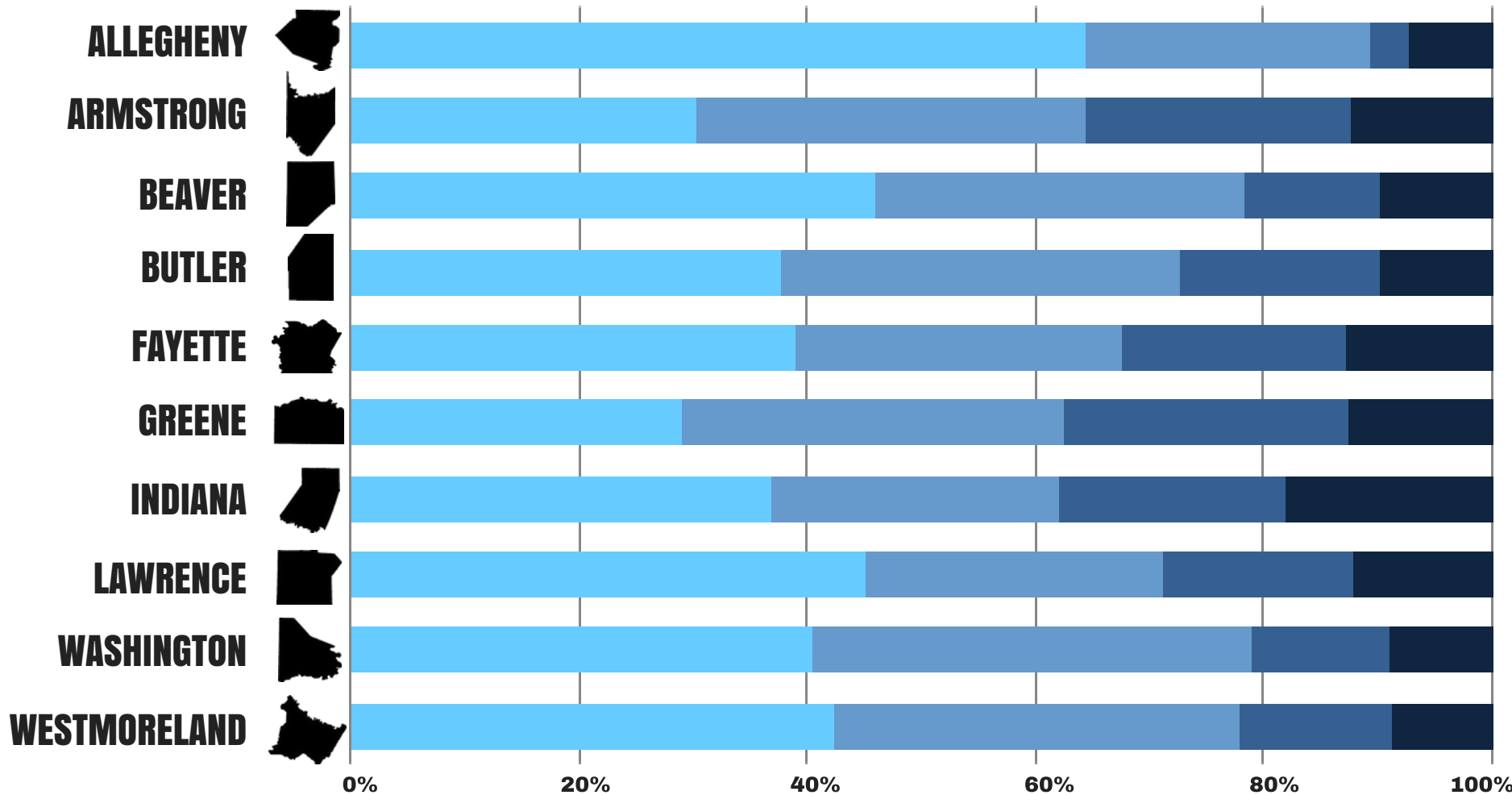




How far do you commute to work?
