## **CommuteInfo<sup>sm</sup> Announces On-Line Regional Park-n-Ride Inventory**

August 2, 2007 - Pittsburgh, PA; The Southwestern Pennsylvania Commission's CommuteInfo<sup>sm</sup> website has now made detailed data sheets available in PDF format for park-n-ride facilities in Southwestern Pennsylvania. These data sheets allow visitors to get a sense of any given park-n-ride facility--its location, cost (if any), and amenities--all from the comfort of home.

"The on-line regional park-n-ride information is another way we can make it easier for commuters to find a better way to work," said Jim Hassinger, SPC Executive Director. "Now commuters can log on to [www.commuteinfo.org](http://www.commuteinfo.org) and find the most convenient park-n-ride anywhere in the region, whether they're interested in taking transit or they want to find out which park-n-ride lots can be used for car- and vanpool parking."

The park-n-ride data sheets include but are not limited to the following information:

- Facility location (including exact address, nearby landmarks and descriptions, and distance from downtown Pittsburgh)
- Number of parking spaces, and whether they are striped
- Facility ownership information

- Parking fee, if any
- Public transit service provider(s) for the facility, and the routes they travel, with links to the agency site

Each data sheet also lists the following individual facility amenities where available:

- Lighting and signs
- Security
- Telephone
- Bus layover area
- Handicapped spaces
- Trash cans, benches, and restrooms
- Route Information

CommutelInfo<sup>sm</sup> is a program of the Southwestern Pennsylvania Commission, operated in partnership with transportation management associations, transportation providers, businesses and non-profit service organizations throughout Southwestern PA. The CommuteInfo<sup>sm</sup> program is designed to serve commuters and employers as a clearinghouse for information about transit, carpooling, and vanpooling. The program serves employers and commuters in Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Butler, Fayette, Greene, Indiana, Lawrence, Washington, and Westmoreland counties.
