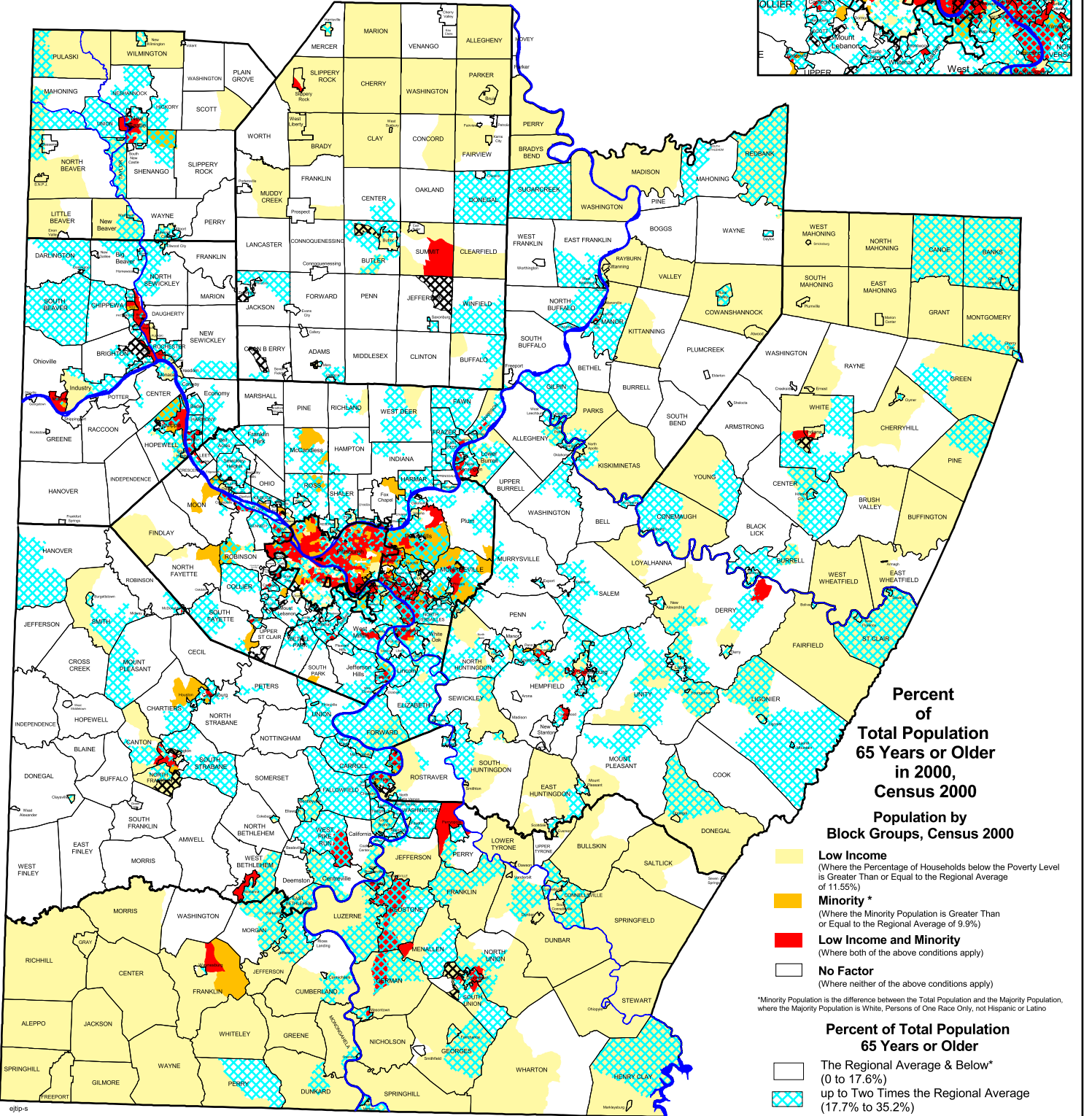
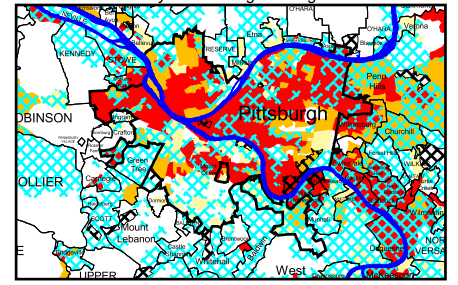


# Low Income & Minority Population by US Census Block Group with Percent of Population 65 years or Older in 2000 by US Census Block Group

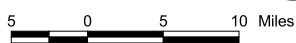
- Low Income**  
(Where the Percentage of Households below the Poverty Level is Greater Than or Equal to the Regional Average of 11.55%)
- Minority \***  
(Where the Minority Population is Greater Than or Equal to the Regional Average of 9.9%)
- Low Income and Minority**  
(Where both of the above conditions apply)
- No Factor**  
(Where neither of the above conditions apply)

\*Minority Population is the difference between the Total Population and the Majority Population, where the Majority Population is White, Persons of One Race Only, not Hispanic or Latino

**Percent of Total Population  
65 Years or Older**

- The Regional Average & Below\*  
(0 to 17.6%)
- up to Two Times the Regional Average  
(17.7% to 35.2%)
- more than Two Times the Regional Average  
(35.3% to 100%)

\*The Regional Average of Total Population 65 Years or Older in 2000 was 17.6%
