


Distribution of Farms by Size





Top 5 Farm Animals in Allegheny County Compared to the Region






Distribution of Farms by Size





Top 5 Farm Animals in Armstrong County Compared to the Region






Distribution of Farms by Size





Top 5 Farm Animals in Beaver County Compared to the Region






Distribution of Farms by Size





Top 5 Farm Animals in Butler County Compared to the Region








Distribution of Farms by Size





Top 5 Farm Animals in Fayette County Compared to the Region






Distribution of Farms by Size








Distribution of Farms by Size

Top 5 Farm Animals in Indiana County Compared to the Region






Distribution of Farms by Size





Top 5 Farm Animals in Lawrence County Compared to the Region








Distribution of Farms by Size





Top 5 Farm Animals in Washington County Compared to the Region








Distribution of Farms by Size
