- ◆2002 Three Rivers Wet Weather (3RWW) issues regionalization report
- ◆2005 –Heinz School of Public Policy and Management at Carnegie Mellon University
- ◆2007 Task Force recommendation

- ◆2008 SPC Regional Policy Committee recommendation
- ◆2008 SPC Board approves resolution
- ◆2013 SPC creates dues-fundedWater Resource Center

Stormwater: Initial Focus – Here to Stay


- ♦ Initial State \$\$ for Act 167 no longer available

Establishing Priority Projects

- Commissioners Water, Sewer Infrastructure are KEY areas of focus
 - Resume Regional Sewer Inventory (2021) + Regional Gap/Needs Assessment
 - Building a regional water/sewer data model w/ 3RWW, others
 - Data & mapping assistance to small water & sewer authorities
 - USGS proposed 3D-Hydro Pilot Study
- County Planning Staff cross-collab as needed (Act 167 & HMP, GIS & more)
- COGs & Municipalities in-person & virtual trainings (mostly EV so far)
- Stakeholders Establish a water monitoring technical assistance/gear program similar to the SPC Active Transportation Bike Counting Program
 - Earthviews.net: a "360 ° Google Street View" for rivers begin mapping in Fall 2023
- SPC Internal Improve enviro GIS data store; departmental cross-collaboration
